COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS IN MEDICINE FISCAL YEAR 2015 FAST FACTS



- Over 31,800 patient visits completed last year, which is more than 2,600 visits per month.
- CVIM provided prevention, wellness, education and treatment to 1,330 new patients.
- 380 licensed clinicians and support volunteer professionals donated more than 50,000 hours of their time and talent.
- Dentist and hygiene professionals provided dental care to 733 children in the clinic and through community outreach programs.
- Our bilingual social worker provided social services to 375 patients, during 718 visits, helping to address the many complex life issues experienced by people living in poverty.
- CVIM dispensed more than 25,100 free prescription medications during 8,700 dispensary visits.
- CVIM's Chronic Disease Management program served 948 patients who suffer from chronic illness.
- 333 CVIM patients and family members participated in wellness programs.
- CVIM's Transitional Care Program provided continuity of care to 206 vulnerable, uninsured patients who were
 accepted into our clinic after being discharged from an emergency room or an inpatient hospital stay.
