



## Executive Board President Ursinus College

### Order No. 1-2019 Appointment of the Commission on Judicial Procedural Reform at Ursinus College

According to the powers vested in the Executive Board President in the Constitution Article II Section 2.03A1 and the responsibility that this position holds in representing the student body, I hereby order the following:

1. The creation of the Commission on Judicial Procedural Reform
  - a. This body shall consist of no more than 7 members of the student body, of which, no more than half shall be representatives of the UCSG
  - b. This commission shall publish a report by the end of the second semester of the 2019-2020 Academic Year.
  - c. This commission shall offer recommendations to the Ursinus College Board of Trustees
2. This commission shall investigate issues of both judicial malpractice and judicial unclarity through the student handbook
  - a. Investigation will occur not only through the student handbook, but also through interviews of students and administrators
  - b. Names may be redacted in the case that interviewees fear retaliation from administrators or other students.
3. The head of this commission, hereby referred to as the *Chairperson*, shall delegate tasks of research and of investigation to the commission
  - a. The chairperson shall not vote on investigative matters unless in the case of a tie
  - b. Garrett Graham Bullock is appointed to the position of *Chairperson*
4. The results of this commission shall be publicly available to the extent permitted by the Student Conduct Handbook and the law
