

Ursinus College Education Department

The following is an amendment to Chapter III, Article 322 of the PA School Health Code, which became effective on July 15, 1972, and is still in effect:

Each pre-student, student teacher and volunteer participating in student activities shall provide to the school administrator a report of a negative tuberculin test, showing no active tuberculosis, dated no earlier than six (6) months before the start of the pre-student, student teaching or volunteer activities.

Compliance by pre-student, student teachers, interns, aides, tutors, and students involved in teaching experiences is mandated as of September 1, 1972.
