

## **Ursinus Sustainability Committee Expectations:**

### Term:

Regular members: 2 years;  
Student members: 1 year

### Mission:

The committee will provide direction to the subcommittees, advocate for sustainability within their areas, and promote the implementation of the Climate and Sustainability Action Plan.

Committee meetings: Monthly

### Reporting:

- UCSC will give updates at Staff Assembly meetings
- Faculty on UCSC will be asked to give occasional updates at faculty meetings when relevant,
- UCSC will send quarterly email reports to the faculty/staff,
- Annual report to President Fong.

### Specific member expectations:

- Read/be familiar with the relevant chapter of the CSAP
- advocate for CSAP-related sustainability changes within your department/area
  
- Attend committee meetings - an hour each month
- report to the committee about things that relevant department/area is doing toward the CSAP and/or subcommittee recommendations
- Edit/review the relevant portions of the annual UCSC report to the President

### At department meetings:

- talk to folks in relevant department/area to see if they'd be willing to make changes suggested,
- identify a few things that could be prioritized for action,
- work with folks who are interested to make those changes (students if possible so they get the experience)
- promote recommendations of the subcommittees to relevant department/area (Energy Conservation measures, for example)
