COVID19 information and expectations for contractors and vendors working on campus

During this unprecedented time of COVID19, the College expects that its contractors and vendors performing work on campus fully comply with all federal, state and local laws, regulations, guidance, and recommendations, including but not limited to CDC guidelines and recommendations at www.cdc.gov/coronavirus and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (e.g., Governor and State Health Department) orders, guidelines and recommendations. It is the responsibility of each contractor and vendor to provide education and training to employees that work on our campus to ensure such compliance and thereby contain and prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus prior to the start of work.

For example, CDC guidelines include practicing physical distancing and good hygiene, staying home when sick, and knowing the signs and symptoms of the virus. Additionally, pursuant to the PA Secretary of Health order, issued April 15, 2020 and updated [November 17, 2020](#), all persons present at a work site are required to wear a mask or some type of face covering that does not interfere with the work or present a hazard.
