

Remember these simple tips to reduce and prevent fire hazards in your home office.

DO NOT overload electrical circuits and extension cords.

DO NOT put cords under rugs or heavy furniture.

DO NOT use staples or nails to attach cords.

DO NOT use extension cords as a permanent solution.

DO verify that each level of your home has at least one smoke alarm. Test these smoke alarms regularly.

DO have a fire extinguisher handy and know how to use it.
