- 5. Briefly describe a recent art-related "Aha!" moment: A recent "Aha!" moment would be the first time I made a successful print with the stencil method I'm working with. I had spent about two hours hunched over my desk, delicately carving out this stencil made from acetate. There had been a substantial amount of trial and error beforehand with other methods, so my expectations were exceedingly low. I applied the stencil and made the print using this acrylic concoction I make, and it came out so clean and crisp- it was just a feeling of relief and success that is quite hard to match.
