Japanese Requirements (32 credits)

Courses: Students pursuing teaching certification in Japanese are required to take the following courses: JPN-211, 212, 311, 312, 328; EAS-224; HIST-151; and EAS-299, 314, or 400. Students may also need to take JPN-111 and 112 as prerequisites for the other courses, depending on their language skills upon arrival at Ursinus.

Study Abroad: Language majors and students preparing for certification are also required to supplement their work at Ursinus by spending a summer, a semester or an entire year in a foreign country in a program approved by the department.

Competency Exams: In addition to the course requirements, students are required to pass a qualifying examination before they will be admitted to candidacy for certification and a competency examination before being certified. These tests will examine students' linguistic competence, orally and in writing, testing phonetics, conversation, grammar and composition. The exit exam will also check their knowledge of Japanese literature and culture, including the arts, history and geography.
