

LINQ AND CCAP DEVELOPMENT FUNDS

As we grow our offerings for the Quest curriculum, the Dean's office is offering professional development funding to assist with the creation of new LINQ and CCAP courses. See the details below.

What will be funded:

LINQ: Proposals to develop sibling LINQ courses for the spring 2024 or fall 2024 semester with a concrete plan for when it will be offered again. Sibling links are those in which students register for one of two linked courses. The two courses meet together and have shared activities and group work during the semester to accomplish the LINQ goals. It is easiest if the two courses are scheduled at the same time, but this is not a requirement. Each faculty member involved in the LINQ will receive \$250 once the course is approved by academic council for the LINQ designation.

Examples of Sibling LINQs:

- MUS-207 History of Jazz and DANC-330 History of Jazz Dance
- BIO-350 Neuropharmacology and MCS-275 Drugs and Media Production
- PHYS-110 Physics on Screen and FS-101 Intro to Film Studies

CCAP: Proposals to develop a nonmajors CCAP course for spring 2024 or fall 2024 semester with a concrete plan for when it will be offered again. Many of the existing CCAP courses are also departmental major capstones. However, courses that attract students from a wide-array of majors can be beneficial for helping students reflect on their whole college experience. We would like to increase the number of these types of CCAPs offered. The faculty member involved in the CCAP will receive \$250 once the course is approved by academic council for the CCAP designation.

Examples of CCAPS for nonmajors:

- MATH-400 Mathematics for Human Flourishing
- MUS-301 What is Music?
- POL-336 Science and the Common Good

We also have two existing CCAP courses that anyone can teach and make their own. Sample syllabi can be made available to you. – You can propose to teach one of these with the funds as well:

- IDS-402: What Will I Do? (a 2 credit CCAP)
- IDS-405 Who Do I Want to Be: Reflections on Your Ursinus Education from CIE to CCAP
